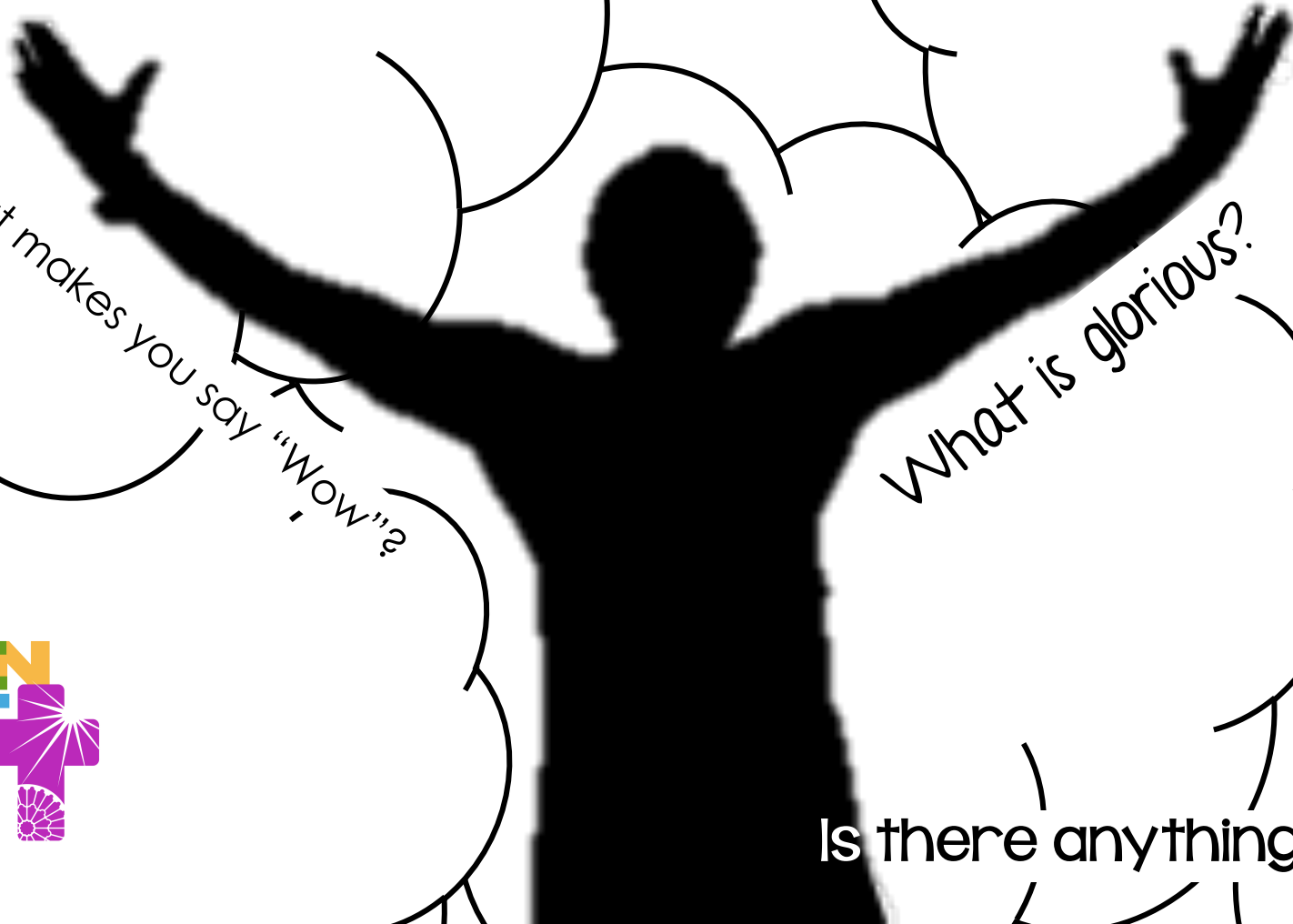


Moses said, "Please show me your glory." (Exodus 33:18) He was wanting to see God face to face.
